

## ANNUAL ACADEMIC APPOINTMENT ROUND 2010 Academic Level A-E



The ANU College of Law plays a leading role, nationally and internationally, in educating lawyers, producing cutting-edge scholarship, and sharing its knowledge, skills, and values by broad engagement with the community. All of its activities are informed by a strong ethos of law reform and social justice, and it provides a highly collegial and egalitarian workplace that values initiative and creativity and promotes personal and collective satisfaction.

2010 marks the College's 50th anniversary and its 11th annual appointment round. This year, the College invites applications in all areas of law, at all levels of appointment, but has identified particular needs in the areas of military law, international law (including human rights), and international trade law, and the private law areas of property, equity, contract, and tort.

The number and level of appointments will depend on the range and mix of applications and a 'just-in-time' assessment of available resources. As part of the round, appointments may be made under the College's Teaching Fellowship scheme: these are full-time Level A appointments with a reduced teaching load to enable the pursuit of a PhD.

The ANU is consistently ranked internationally as amongst the world's top universities and as the leading university in Australia (*The Times HES* 2009). Successful applicants to the ANU College of Law are enthusiastic teachers, intellectually curious researchers, willing contributors to the collective enterprise, and potential leaders.
