Jane Connors currently works in the Office of the UN High Commissioner for Human Rights, where she has responsibility for the oversight of the work of the Committees on the Rights of the Child and Economic, Social and Cultural Rights, and follow-up to human rights reporting. From 1996-2002, as Chief, Women's Rights Section of the UN Division for the Advancement of Women, she was responsible for the technical and substantive servicing of the Committee on the Elimination of Discrimination against Women. Prior to joining the UN, Ms Connors was a senior lecturer at the School of Oriental and African Studies in the University of London where she taught and wrote on human rights issues, in particular on the human rights of women.

In this seminar she will be addressing recent efforts to reform the UN human rights treaty body system.
