Father Frank Brennan is an Adjunct Fellow at the Research School of Pacific and Asian Studies, ANU and Associate Director, Uniya - the Jesuit Social Justice Centre, Adjunct Professor in Law, Australian Catholic University and Visiting Professor of Law, University of Notre Dame Law School. He chairs the Visiting Committee, Faculty of Law, Griffith University. His books on Aboriginal issues include *The Wik Debate*, *One Land One Nation*, *Sharing The Country*, and *Land Rights Queensland Style*. His books on civil liberties are *Too Much Order With Too Little Law* and *Legislating Liberty*. His latest book *Tampering With Asylum* compares Australia's asylum policies with other First World countries.

He is currently completing a paper for the Australian Catholic Social Justice Council on Unitisation and Maritime Boundary Issues in the Timor Gap. He returned from East Timor on 9 July, having completed a round of consultations with both governments and Woodside.
