

Birke Häcker read law at the Universities of Oxford, Bonn and Tübingen, obtaining both an English and a German undergraduate law degree. In Oxford (where she was a Prize Fellow at All Souls College from 2001-2008) she undertook comparative research into English and German private law (mainly contract, property and restitution) and in 2007 completed a doctoral thesis entitled 'Consequences of Impaired Consent Transfers'. In 2007/08 Birke was a Lecturer in Law at Lady Margaret Hall, Oxford, teaching Roman law and the law of contract). In 2009 she took up a post at the University of Munich where she will deliver an introductory lecture series on the common law.
