Molly O'Brien & Gregor Urbas receive Teaching Award

Ms Molly O'Brien and Dr Gregor Urbas from the ANU College of Law have been awarded one of the University's Teaching Enhancement Grants (\$10,000) for their project 'Evidence Law in Context'.

The purpose of their project is to develop an interactive digital video, Evidence Law in Context, which will be used to support teaching in the Evidence course.

"The video will portray a series of short (1 to 3 minute) trial vignettes that will be crafted to illustrate principles of evidence as they arise in the courtroom. The vignettes will be based on fictional but realistic legal cases and will be acted by students and practicing lawyers. Each vignette will be designed to raise several difficult evidentiary issues and will be formatted for stop-action viewing."

"The goal of this project is to bring the law of Evidence to life in the classroom."

The project will draw on the experience and expertise of colleagues in the College who have successfully developed the CrimPro II materials for Criminal Law and Procedure.
