* All students from a non-law background MUST complete LAWS8153 (Introduction to Legal Reasoning and Research) as part of their program except those students in the Environmental Law stream

* Courses run all day unless otherwise stated. E-mails are sent to students prior to courses starting, setting out exact times.

* **Melb** - These courses are held at ANU House, Melbourne (Level 11, 52 Collins St). ANU students who wish to enrol require a permission code which can be obtained from pgadmin.law@anu.edu.au

* if you do not have an enrolment in the first half of the year (Summer/Semester 1/Autumn) or in the second half of the year (Winter/Semester 2/Spring) you will need to apply for a Leave of Absence for that 6 month period.
