Application Deadline:

- Applications close Wednesday **10 August 2011**. Applicants will be notified of the outcome by **17 August 2011**.

Administrative Fee (payable to the Law School, non-refundable):

- A non-refundable A\$500 deposit towards the administrative fee will be due no later than **29 August 2011**.
- The balance of the non-refundable administrative fee (A\$1000) will be due no later than **19 September 2011**.

Tuition fee for two summer semester courses (payable to the University Administration):

- The tuition fees for international students will be due no later than **16 November 2011**.
- Commonwealth supported ANU students who are Australian Citizens can pay their student contribution through HECS-HELP.

Accommodation (payable to the Law School):

- A 50% (A\$750) accommodation deposit will be due no later than **17 October 2011**. The balance of the accommodation cost will be payable to the ANU Law School no later than **21 November 2011**.
- The accommodation fee does not include meals and other personal expenses.
- It is imperative that arrive in Tuscaloosa by **Saturday, 7 January 2012**. Accommodation will not be available prior to **Saturday, 7 January 2012** or beyond the end of the program. The program will finish midday on **13 February 2012** and students are expected to leave the accommodation no later than mid-day the following day, **Tuesday 14 February 2012**.
- As accommodation is booked as a group, students will be charged accommodation costs from **Saturday, 7 January 2012** to the end of the program, irrespective of individual arrival or departure dates.

Airfares:

- The lowest specific airfare included in the sample budget is based on a low-season, round the world ticket. Other departure dates and tickets may be more expensive.
- Airfares in cost estimate are indicative only.
- Participants are required to make their own travel arrangements.

Additional Expenses:

- The sample budget set out on the information leaflet does not include additional (personal) expenses.
- Participants will in particular be responsible for the cost of any additional travel they may decide to undertake.
- Participants are responsible for any personal expenses, eg. telephone, hire cars, etc.

Assessment:

- The assessment for the special elective, **Comparative Environmental Law**, will involve a substantial piece of research along with smaller assessments, which may include short written pieces, presentations and class participation. (It is expected that students will already have begun to develop their research and writing skills. Further, students should already have done research essays in other courses.) The assessment for the survey course is a 100% exam on the morning of Tuesday 14 February 2012.
- Students will be expected to access preliminary material on WATTLE up to a month before classes begin, so they should be near to internet access.

Enrolment:

- Please note that application for the course **DOES NOT** enrol the student in the courses. **Students should enrol in the summer course via the Law School Office** after they have been accepted in the program.
- **Students have to enrol in TWO separate ANU law courses**, namely LAWS2247 Survey of US Law AND LAWS2248 Selected Topics in Australian-American Comparative Law.
