Dr. Justice D. Y. Chandrachud is a Judge of the Bombay High Court. After completing an LL.M and S.J.D. from Harvard Law School in 1984, he practised Constitutional Law in India. He was Additional Solicitor General of India till his appointment on the Bench in 2000.

His Lecture will discuss the role of Courts in ensuring that Human Rights remain not just a statement of desirable goals but are effectively enforced for the benefit of those who need them the most : the marginalised and the poor. The lecture will focus on personal liberty and its relationship with socio-economic rights particularly in developing societies.
