The ANU International Law Society (ILS) has been formed and registered as a Chapter of the International Law Students' Association.

The newly formed ANU ILS aims to provide students with new and exciting ways of engaging with international law. ANU offers a number of academic opportunities to study international law, and has had exceptional recent success internationally with the ANU Jessup Moot team winning the World Championships last year.

The ILS has been set up with the purpose of further connecting ANU students with the international law community. Through the ILS, we hope to increase the knowledge and accessibility of international law opportunities for students, LLB, JD and LLM alike. By running social events for members, we aim to foster a community and increase the profile of international law amongst students at the ANU.

In 2012, the ILS will publish quarterly international law publications; organise teams for domestic and international mooted competitions; run a peer-assisted learning program; provide students with information about career opportunities and pathways in international law; and run social events to engage students and encourage a community of international law at the ANU.

The ILS at the ANU is the first Australian chapter of the International Law Students Association (ILSA). Professor Hilary Charlesworth AM, Director of the ANU Centre for International Governance and Justice and recently appointed judge ad hoc to the ICJ, is serving as the Society's inaugural patron. Don Anton and Kevin Boreham are acting as the Society's staff advisers.
