

# The Prime Minister's Australia Asia Awards

*Establish your international career in Asia with an international study or research opportunity as well as an internship.*

[The Prime Minister's Australia Asia Awards](#) are a unique opportunity for you to undertake international study and research related to your Australian degree, and gain international work experience through an internship, building your professional network in Asia.

The Awards are open to Australian undergraduates and postgraduates in any field of study. Twenty postgraduate and twenty undergraduate awards are available each year.

Applications open 1 April and close 30 June 2011

## Are you a Postgraduate student?

The Prime Minister's Australia Asia Postgraduate Award provides financial support for students to undertake study or research in Asia towards their Australian postgraduate qualification, at Masters or PhD level either by course-work or research, in any field of study. This Award provides up to \$63,500 towards travel and establishment allowances, tuition and internship contributions, and travel insurance.

## Award structure: two stages

1. Full-time study/research component for up to 12 months (one semester or 6 months minimum).
2. Internship component for up to 12 months (minimum of two months). The internship is compulsory for undergraduates and may be part-time.

Awards are available for Australian recipients to conduct their program in; China (including Hong Kong and Macau SARs), India, Indonesia, Japan, Malaysia, Republic of Korea, Singapore, Taiwan, Thailand and Vietnam.

## How to apply

Applications are submitted on-line through the Endeavour Online (EOL) IT System. Applications will be assessed by an education panel at the ANU and shortlisted prior to being sent off for final consideration. Applications with a distinction average and above will be considered by the panel.
