**REAPPOINTMENT TO THE ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW COUNCIL**

Attorney-General Philip Ruddock today announced the re-appointment of Professor Robin Creyke as a part-time member of the Administrative Review Council.

“Professor Creyke’s extensive knowledge of administrative law has made an invaluable contribution to the work of the Council and I look forward to her continuing involvement as a member of that organisation,” Mr Ruddock said.

Professor Creyke has been a member of the Council since 1999. She has been re-appointed for a further three years.

Professor Creyke is a Professor of Law at the Australian National University where she teaches public, administrative and constitutional law.

She has published extensively on various aspects of administrative law and is the President of the Australian Institute of Administrative Law and a Commissioner of the Australian Capital Territory’s Independent Competition and Regulatory Commission.

The Council plays an important role in monitoring and advising the Government on the Commonwealth administrative law system. Through its reports and best-practice guidelines, the Council provides practical assistance on the making and review of government decisions.
