

STATEMENT BY THE COLLEGE OF LAW AND AUSTRALIAN NATIONAL UNIVERSITY

Statement by The College of Law and The Australian National University

The College of Law and The Australian National University jointly announce that they have, without admissions, settled their dispute in relation to the adoption of the name ANU College of Law resulting from the re-organisation of the University's legal teaching and research disciplines, given The College of Law's name and trade marks.

The University has given undertakings to The College to avoid confusion including by using the phrase ANU Legal Workshop exclusively for the University's graduate diploma in legal practice program, always using the initials ANU to precede College as in "ANU College of Law" and by establishing and maintaining a formal written Policy to give effect to the undertakings.

The court proceedings between the parties have been withdrawn with no order as to costs. No further comment will be provided.
