

Study Plan FDD – Second Semester Start - Full-Time Degree Pattern¹

The Law component of a Flexible Double Degree (FDD) program consist of 144 units in total or the equivalent of three years full-time study, distributed as follows:

- 15 compulsory courses (90 units)
- 9 Law elective courses (54 units)

The FDD program with Law is intended to be completed in five years full-time or up to a maximum of eleven years part-time including periods of leave or suspension.

The structure for the Law component is the same for each FDD program. Students should consult the College responsible for the other part of the program in order to ensure that they meet the requirements for the part of the program.
